This new edition is effectively a facsimile copy of the 2000 original publication – so does not incorporate any errata. For a variety of reasons this was the best way to easily bring the publication back into print quickly & simply, and is largely thanks to the effort of Dennis Shorthouse at [OMM](#) . This reprint features the rule pack presented as a spiral bound book (rather than the original hole punched loose-leaf version*) - the new layout will allow the rulebook to be laid flat; and it has the facility for the Quick Reference Sheet (QRS) and Data Cards to be torn out to be used loose if desired or left as aprt of the main rulebook.
